Communication Diary & Reading Log

Students in K to 4 are required to have their Communication Diary at school each day. The new diary page will be sent home each fortnight. Please add any relevant information for the teacher in the diary, or send the teacher an email. Students in Stage 3 will use google classroom on their iPads, along with their iPad calendar.

It is an imperative that all students continue to read each night to consolidate and improve their reading skills. Students in ES1 to Year 2 will use a home reading log to track their nights of reading. Students in Stage 2 will use their Communication Diary to track their reading nights and the Stage 3 students will email their class teacher/s once they reach 25 nights.

Parent helpers are invited into the classroom. If you would like to be involved in the classroom, a letter will be sent home early in Term 1 for you to indicate your availability. Your support is greatly appreciated by all teaching staff.
